

The show: Set Up

Fascinated by the pomp of the big productions, three eccentric characters try to emulate them the way they know: with a more than dubious taste and an octogenarian imagination. They even have got the wrong timetable and are half an hour late. In the end, all this does not prevent them from displaying incompetence and lack of coordination at the highest level.





Juggling, magic, unicycles and impossible balancing acts, all with a lot of humour and fast-paced action. These are the main ingredients of this show for all kinds of audiences, which can be performed in the street, in theatre or in other multipurpose spaces.

Duration of the show: 60 minutes

Set-up time: 2 hours
Dismantling time: 1 hour

Venue

The show can be performed in the street or indoors.

Stage space: 8 m. deep, 8 m. wide and 4 m. high. Flat ground, without unevenness or potholes and not sloping. Grass and sandy grounds are not suitable.



Other

Dressing rooms (with mirror and washbasin) for 3 people as close as possible to the performance space. It is highly recommended to have chairs for the audience.

6 fences to delimit the space behind the stage (in the street).

A place to park the van, close to the

performance space.

Sound and lighting

The company has its own sound system.

1,500W / 220V socket in the stage area.

Lighting equipment provided by the organisation, if necessary.
